



Arrival and Dismissal





Learning Behaviors


Student demonstrates...



Student Technology Use in School

Students may <u>only</u> use their personal technology before and after school

Devices must remain off and in backpack during school hours

If a student has their cell phone out during the school day:

- 1. Staff will tell them to turn it off and put it in their backpack.
- 2. If they are caught with it a 2nd time, staff will call administration to come and get the phone from the student.
- 3. At the end of the day, the student will go to the office and retrieve their phone.
- 4. If it happens again, administration will take the phone and a parent will be called to come get the phone.

Students are *never* required or expected to bring a personal device to school




